Questions

A car yard pays its salespeople 5% for the first \$10 000 of the value of the cars they sell, 4% for the next \$10 000, and 3% of any amount after that. Calculate the amount of commission received if the following cars are sold.

- 1 A \$7000 Datsun

- 2 A \$39 990 Commodore

- 3 A \$17 499 Charade

A fruit picker is paid \$4.30 per box of fruit picked.

- 4 How much would a picker earn for 37 boxes picked over a day?

- 5 If a picker earns \$812.70 in a week, how many boxes of fruit have they picked?

- 6 If a picker picked 46 boxes over a 10-hour period, what was their average hourly rate of pay?

A real estate office pays its salespeople a weekly retainer of \$220 plus commission of 2.5% for the first \$200 000 of the value of each property sold and 2% of each amount after that. Calculate the commission received if the following houses are sold.

- 7 A \$540 000 house

- 8 A \$795 600 house

- 9 During the 4 weeks of February, Daniel sold houses worth \$472 500 and \$618 000. What was his total income for that month including retainer?

- 10 During a 4-week period, Katrina sold two units worth \$384 000 and \$216 000 and a house worth \$593 700. What was her total income?

- 11 A commission of \$9800 would be received on the sale of a house of what price?

Outworkers who sew T-shirts together are paid a wage of \$3 per hour plus \$1.45 for each T-shirt sewn together. Calculate the average hourly wage for each of the following workers.
